She will be remembered for her acting skills playing the role of Blanche Du Boise, in Tennessee Williams' "A Street Car Named Desire" in both the Sinhala production as well as the English. She won best supporting actress in that year for her role in the Sinhala production.

A friendly, socially active lady who gave back to her community, not to mention glamorous even in her 90's, she'll also be remembered as a great cook by those who had the privilege of knowing her. Having operated her own restaurent, "Roma's Kitchen" for many years, she even received exposure in the Los Angeles Times for her culinary expertise. Her recipes went on to being distributed to a global readership via "Jayam's Good News".

Celebrating her life, and hearing about her work, we see the shadows of our school motto "Non Sibi Sed Omnibus" - Not for one but for all, in how she lived and loved, especially how during her stint in Indonesia she taught, English and Social Studies at Gandhi Memorial School (an International school) for several years. Even in the USA she operated her own Preschool. In Los Angeles she participated tirelessly in activities that promoted Sri Lankan culture, with her involvement in the Sri Lanka America Association as well as the Sri Lanka Foundation. 



Having reached out to the school in Colombo, completing and submitting the necessary paperwork to form the Bishop's College PPA, the group was simultaneously established as a Non-Profit Entity in the USA, thereby legitimizing the organization completely.

However, in order for it to be a viable entity she had to gather alumni in the United States who would make up the body of the Association.

Fortunately, outside of an official organization Achala Weerasinge had already taken the initiative to gather other Bishopians to form a cricket team. This team was formed in 2015, and consisted of Achala Weerasinghe (Captain), Chandi Wanniarachchi. Eriko Kotandeniva. Rodrigo, Shanaz Mustafa, and Aroshi De Silva. Since 2015, they were already competing against other Sri Lankan school teams in California. It was just a matter of time before the newly formed Association joined with these younger alum, to form the Bishop's College Past Pupils' Association USA.

The year of inception was 2017. Several Bishopians convened to form, and vote-in the founding committee. The very first events held by the association were primarily for Fellowship; Halloween parties, Christmas parties, lunch and tea parties etc.

Subsequently (and notably post-Covid), the events and projects in which the BC PPA USA has engaged, have been fundraising for Bishop's College, educational projects in Sri Lanka, as well as homeless feedings, donation of blankets and hygiene products to the homeless population in Los Angeles County. 




